The town continues to move forward with its plan to construct a new community centre and neighbourhood park in south east Oakville as part of the redevelopment of the former hospital site. The park will be 0.6 ha in size, situated on the north side of the South East Community Centre planned for the site and constructed in conjunction with the community centre.

The town held an open house on November 28, 2017 and had an online survey available for residents until January 12, 2018 to provide input on design options for this park. Thank you to everyone who took the time to share your comments. We have reviewed all of your feedback and would like to follow up with you at an open house on February 8, where staff will be presenting:

- design options for this park
- design options for the open space parcel of land on the southeast corner of the former hospital site
- a high level concept for the proposed Civic Space in front of the preserved former Oakville Trafalgar High School, as well as
- options for a rejuvenated Wallace Park

Recreation and Culture staff will also provide an update on the progress of the design of the South East Community Centre.
