About This Project

COVID-19 Update: Construction projects that provide additional capacity or are essential to the maintenance and repair of Regional infrastructure will continue until further notice. Contractors performing work on behalf of the Region have been encouraged to implement the necessary precautions, procedures and physical distancing measures that meet the guidelines set out by the Province. IMPROVEMENTS

Beginning April 2022, Halton Region will be completing tank cleaning work at the Oakville Southeast Wastewater Treatment Plant, located at 2477 Lakeshore East, in the Town of Oakville, Ward 3. This work is required to maintain performance and efficient operation of the wastewater treatment process.

Halton Region will be cleaning the interior of the tank as part of a scheduled maintenance program. This is required to allow Halton Region to complete a thorough condition assessment of the tank in preparation for rehabilitation which is scheduled for the Spring of 2023.

The tank cleaning work is anticipated to begin in Mid-April 2022 and is expected to be completed in May 2022, weather permitting.

PLANNING AHEAD

To help you plan ahead for the construction activity, please read the project related information below. Wherever possible, mitigation plans will be put in place to minimize disruptions.

The contractor will begin equipment mobilization in early April with the cleanout work to follow. The work will be limited to the west side of the treatment facility as shown in

the adjacent figure. The work is not expected to impact local residents significantly; however, some potential impacts are identified below.

Noise: You may experience increased noise as a result of Regional improvements. We will schedule work in accordance with local noise by-laws.

Truck traffic: You may notice occasional increases in truck traffic along Lakeshore Road. Please be aware and use extra caution while driving.

Odour: You may notice an occasional increase in odours from the Plant during the construction period.
