You are invited to attend and provide input at this meeting hosted by Planning and Development Council.

The purpose of these applications is to allow the creation of nine residential lots for detached dwellings and an expansion of Charnwood Park as recommended through the South Central Public Lands Study.

The subject land is located on the east side of Charnwood Drive, immediately south of Charnwood Park. It is the site of the former Chisholm Public School.

At this time there are no other applications, under the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended, pertaining to the subject land.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Oakville before the proposed official plan amendment is adopted, zoning by-law amendment is passed or before the approval authority gives or refuses to give approval to the draft plan of subdivision:

- a) the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Town of Oakville Council or the Director of Planning Services to the Ontario Municipal Board; and
- b) the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the board, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.

Any submission to the Planning and Development Council, either in hard copy or in electronic format, must be forwarded to the Clerk's department for receipt no later than noon on the May 11, 2015, to ensure its availability to the Members of Council at the meeting. Individuals making oral submissions at the public meeting are requested to submit a written outline of the submission to the Town Clerk. All submissions should include the full name and address of the presenter.

If you wish to be notified of the adoption of the proposed official plan amendment, and the passing of the proposed zoning by-law amendment, or of the refusal of the proposed official plan and proposed zoning

by-law amendment and/or the decision of the approval authority in respect of the proposed plan of subdivision you must make a written request to the Town Clerk at the Town of Oakville, Clerk's department, 1225 Trafalgar Road, Oakville, ON L6H 0H3.
